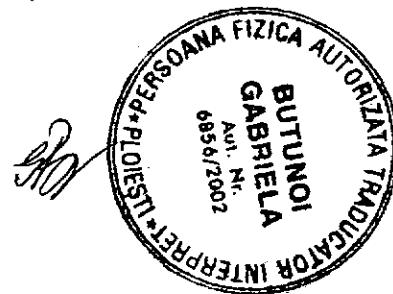
Management's Responsibility for the financial statements
