Reference: Tender procedure organised by CONPET SA for the award of the contract with the object **"Lease services of a number of 15 tank cars suitable and authorised for the transport of gaseous hydrocarbons in liquefied mixture, NSA (Mixture C)"**;

Following the clarifications requested by one of the companies that examined the award documentation for the procedure referred to on the www.conpet.ro website, we inform you of the following:

Request no. 1: „Can Class D tank cars (90 tonnes) also be offered?”

Answer: Class D (90 tonnes) tank cars can be tendered.

Request no. 2: „Do you agree to take over tank cars from various countries (Poland, Germany)?”

Answer: All tank cars will be taken over only in Romania, in a mutually agreed place. Take-over of tank cars covered by this lease in the territory of another country is not accepted.

Request no. 3: „Is it possible for the tax residence certificate to be sent later on, because until 16.02.2021 I do not think they will receive this document from the financial administration (for reasons of coronavirus the receipt of these documents takes longer?”

Answer: According to provisions of Art. 43 Para 6 of CONPET's Joint Procurement Procedural Rules – Revision 3, governing this acquisition, **in the event that the information or documents submitted by economic operators are incomplete or incorrect, or where certain documents are missing, the evaluation committee shall have the right to request clarification to the tenderers in a given time and, where appropriate, additions to the documents submitted by tenderers in the context of the tenders, in accordance with the principles of equal treatment and transparency and without the clarifications/additions requested causing an obvious advantage to any of the tenderer.**

Request no. 4: „The tank cars shall be TUV checked and not ISCIR. Is TUV acknowledged?”

Answer: The tank cars of your company, if they have revisions of the containers carried out by TUV, are recognized in Romania if they show the European conformity mark (pi).

Request no. 5: „Please explain the abbreviations RP, RIF+RRu.”

Answer: The abbreviations RP, RIF+RRu are explained in **Order no. 315 of May 4th, 2011 on the approval of the Railway Standard "Railway vehicles. Types of planned revisions and repairs. Time rules or mileage rules for carrying out planned revisions and repairs" issued by the Ministry of Transport and Infrastructure** (published in the Official Gazette no. 418 of June 15th, 2011).

Please note that your offer will be prepared considering the requirements of the Award Documentation and the indications specified above.
